2. Adapt minimum energy performance standards (MEPS)
3. Develop a certification system for energy service providers
4. Stakeholder workshop on proposed certification system and MEPS
5. Educate stakeholders on the certification system and proposed MEPS

SECBI addresses critical commercialization challenges related to expanding the development and use of sustainable energy alternatives as a means of injecting more affordable and less environmentally-harmful energy technologies into the energy matrices of Caribbean countries.
