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ON GOING EFFORTS

- Barbados Public Sector Smart Energy Programme (with IDB and GoBAR)
- Wind Energy for the island of Carriacou (Grenada)
- Geothermal Resource Development in Dominica (with AfD – financed by the Caribbean Investment Facility)
- Project in Jamaica (developing ESCOs), Guyana (Hydropower, Haiti (mixed) and Dominican Republic (mostly RE), Belize (RE)
- Various research and technology transfer interventions – financed from EU budget lines





UP-COMING

- Sustainable Energy in Eastern Caribbean (SEEC) with Caribbean Development Bank and DFID
- Four countries (BAR, DOM, JAM, SCN) have selected RE/EE
 as focal sector for EDF 11. BAR&SCN RE/EE schools educational aspects; DOM same but also geothermal
- EDF 11 regional programming ongoing; tentative information systems, smart grids, resource assessments, interconnection studies,
- Caribbean Investment Facility now € 40mn will be increased to € 180 mn
- Various EU budget lines (details awaited); FEDER funds for trans-national cooperation (French Regions of MAR, GUA)
